Camp Tahkodah - If you have not already submitted your registration form, the early bird rate has expired. The cost for camp is now \$170. Camp Tahkodah is July 25th-30th. Wilderness Trek - The dates for Trek this year are June 18th - 26th. Remember that we open the sign up by age. You may not sign up until it is open to your grade level. We are working on getting a discount code that you will just type in as you go through online registration. This discount will bring the camp cost down from \$250 to \$150. Mission Trip - We will be going to Piedras Negras, Mexico again this year. We will work with the church we support there on their new building project. This is a great way to broaden our students' awareness of another culture. We will serve alongside the Mexican people there and our students will also see how the kingdom of God is without borders. A passport is required for students to go on this trip.

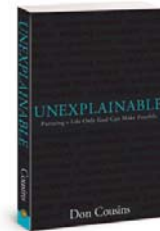

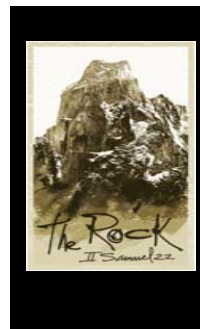
