The following is a great truth that I hope will inspire you to be constant with your Bible reading and Bible study. It comes from the writings of **A. W. Tozer**. "There isn't anything dated in the Book of God. When I go to my Bible, I find dates, but no dating. I mean that I find the sense and the feeling that everything here belongs to me. There is nothing here that is obviously for another people.

Through the inspiration of God's Holy Spirit, it is written to certain people but then it is made so universally applicable that every Christian who reads them today, in any part of the world, in any language or dialect, forgets that they were written to someone else and feels, 'This was written to me. The Holy Spirit had me in mind.' The Word of God is not antiquated or dated; this is living truth for each of us-now! It is just as though God had just heard of our needs or concerns and is speaking to me to help and encourage me in my life."

If we could learn to read the Bible in a very personal sort of way, we would then be reading it as God intends for us to approach His word. It is not mere stories of commands for people long ago, it is God speaking to each of us in a most personal way.

The real problem we face today, is not that the Bible isn't relevant. It is that too many won't listen to what it says! How about you? Are you listening to hear God's voice speaking to you through His word? Do you struggle with finding time to read and hear the message of the One who loves you most? Do you understand that it really was written with you in mind? Whatever else you find time for today, don't neglect to find time for the living word of truth—God's message to you!

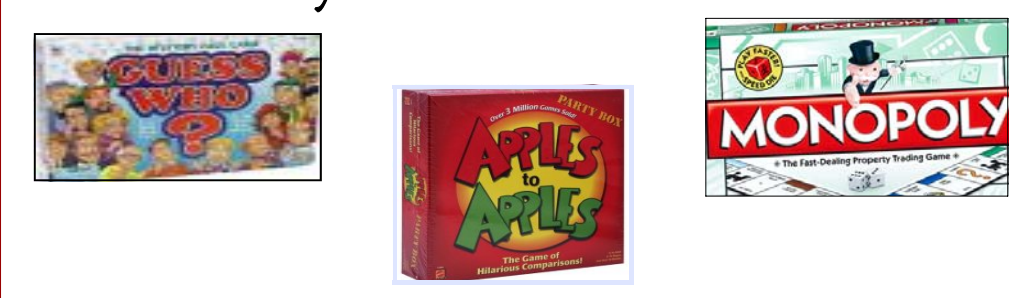
